Description

The project "EU Landscape" was implemented through a three-day transnational programme involving approximately 251 participants from seven partner countries within the CERV framework. The activities promoted the protection and valorisation of cultural landscapes and strengthened cooperation among rural communities.

The programme included official opening sessions, partner presentations, a documentary film screening, group debates, a guided visit, and a round table with experts and local authorities. Cultural activities and participation in a local fair increased public engagement and visibility.

Key achievements include the production and public presentation of a documentary film on the cultural landscape of the LAG PRIZAG area and the signing of a Cooperation Agreement by all partners, establishing a basis for future joint EU projects.

### Description of the activities

The Conference activities were implemented in a clear and logical sequence, following the planned programme and enabling active participation of all partners.

The programme began with the **presentations of project partners**, during which each partner introduced their organization, project role and examples of **best local initiatives** from their respective regions. This initial segment set the framework for mutual understanding, knowledge exchange and partnership cooperation.

Following the partner presentations, a **thematic documentary film** prepared by the host organization, LAG PRIZAG, was screened. The film focused on **landscape features and cultural characteristics of the LAG PRIZAG area** and served as a visual introduction to the main conference topic. After the film screening, participants took part in **structured group work in two debate groups** on the topic “**EU Cultural Landscape**”. The debates were organized in an interactive format, encouraging open dialogue, exchange of opinions and sharing of experiences among all project partners. This was followed by a **joint discussion involving all participants**, allowing different perspectives to be presented and compared in a plenary setting.

In the continuation of the programme, participants joined a **one-hour guided tour focused on the cultural landscape of Novi Marof**, the host town of the Conference. The tour provided practical insight into local examples of cultural and natural heritage, directly linking the theoretical discussions with real-life surroundings. A **joint group photo session** was organized during the visit.

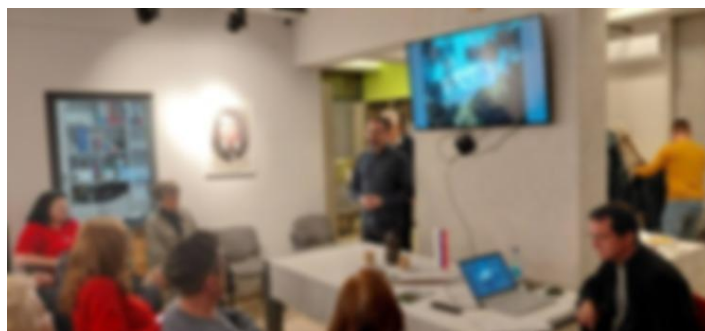


The Conference concluded with a **panel discussion involving experts and representatives of the public sector and local authorities**, who reflected on the presented topics, discussed the importance of preserving and valorizing cultural landscapes, and highlighted opportunities for future cooperation and joint initiatives within EU-funded projects.

In addition to the joint Conference activities, **each project partner organized a multiplier event in their respective country** in accordance with the project objectives and dissemination plan. The events aimed to present the **project results and key topics related to the EU Cultural Landscape** to a wider audience, including local stakeholders and community representatives.

The multiplier events were adapted to the **local context**, encouraged active participation and contributed to the **visibility and impact of the project**, while strengthening cooperation between partners and local communities and supporting future joint initiatives.

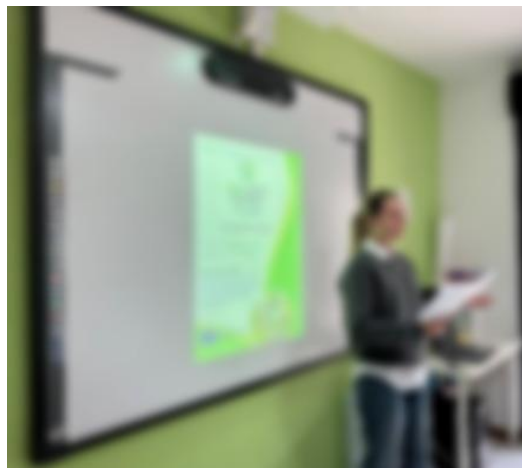

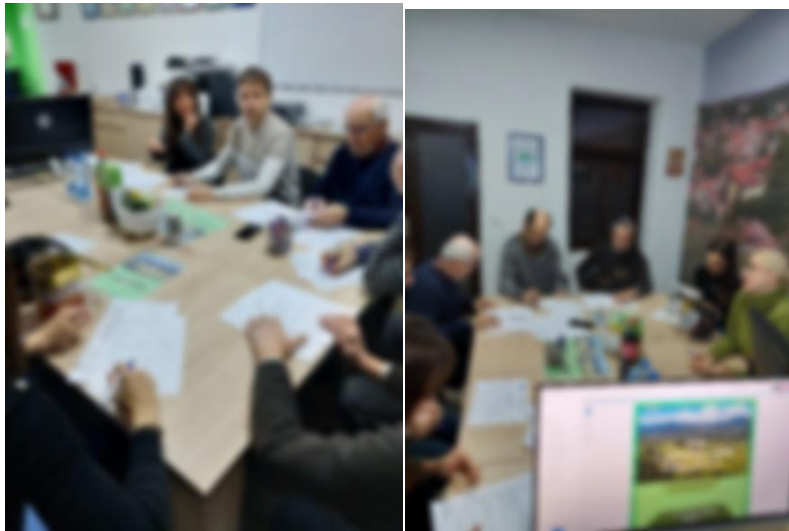


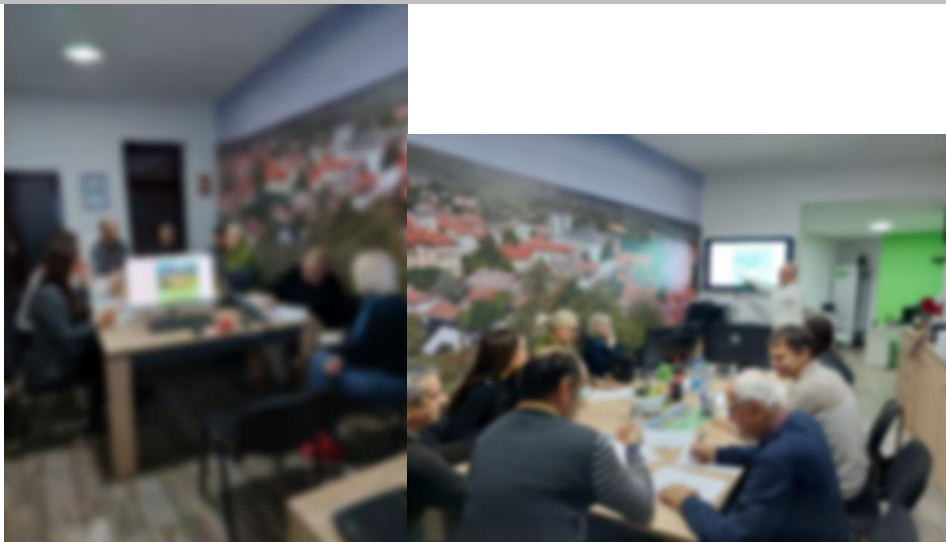

Furthermore, a **project questionnaire was prepared and completed by all partners**, providing structured feedback on the implemented activities and contributing to the evaluation of project outcomes and future cooperation possibilities.

Based on the completed questionnaires, project partners expressed a high level of satisfaction with the overall implementation of the project, particularly highlighting the organization of activities, the quality of workshops, and opportunities for cooperation and exchange of experiences. The feedback indicates that the project largely met its objectives and contributed to the promotion and preservation of the cultural landscape within the LAG PRIZAG area, while also showing strong interest in future cooperation and similar initiatives.
